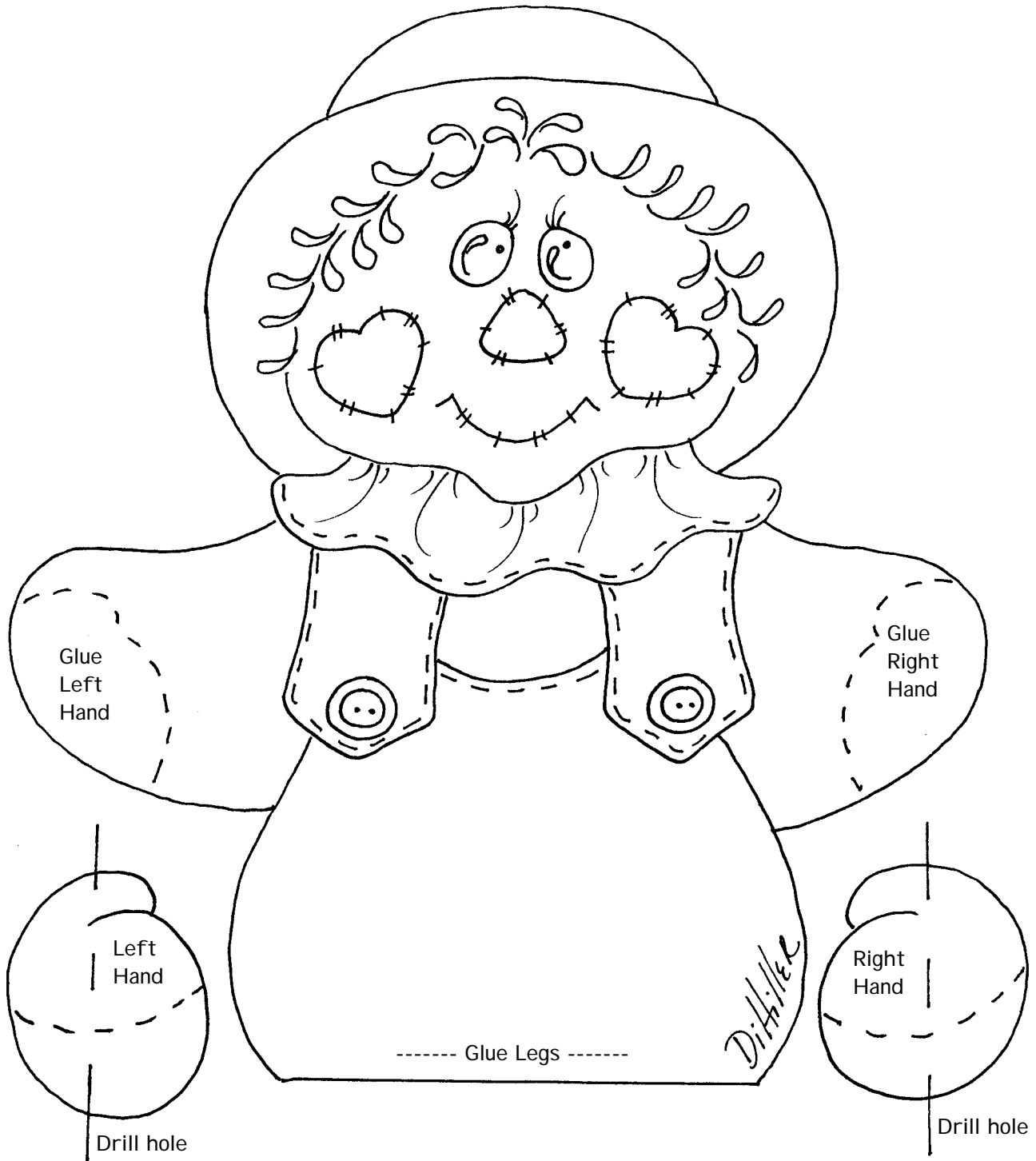
"Charlie . . . Swingin' Scarecrow"

WOOD: Cut body, swing seat, two hands, two legs and two shoes all from 1/2" wood. Drill holes through hands and swing seat.

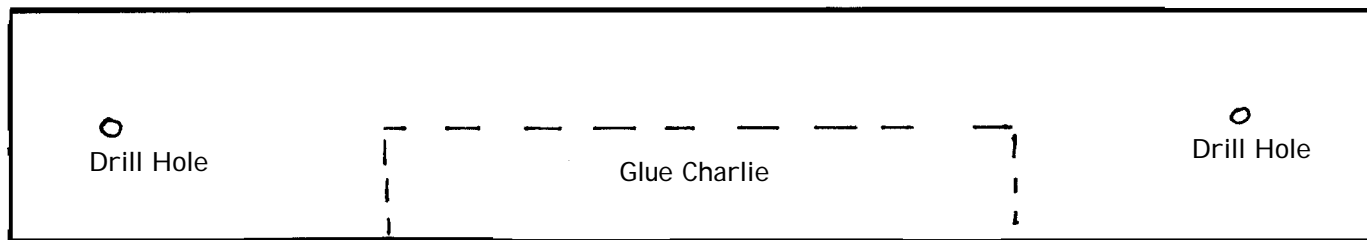
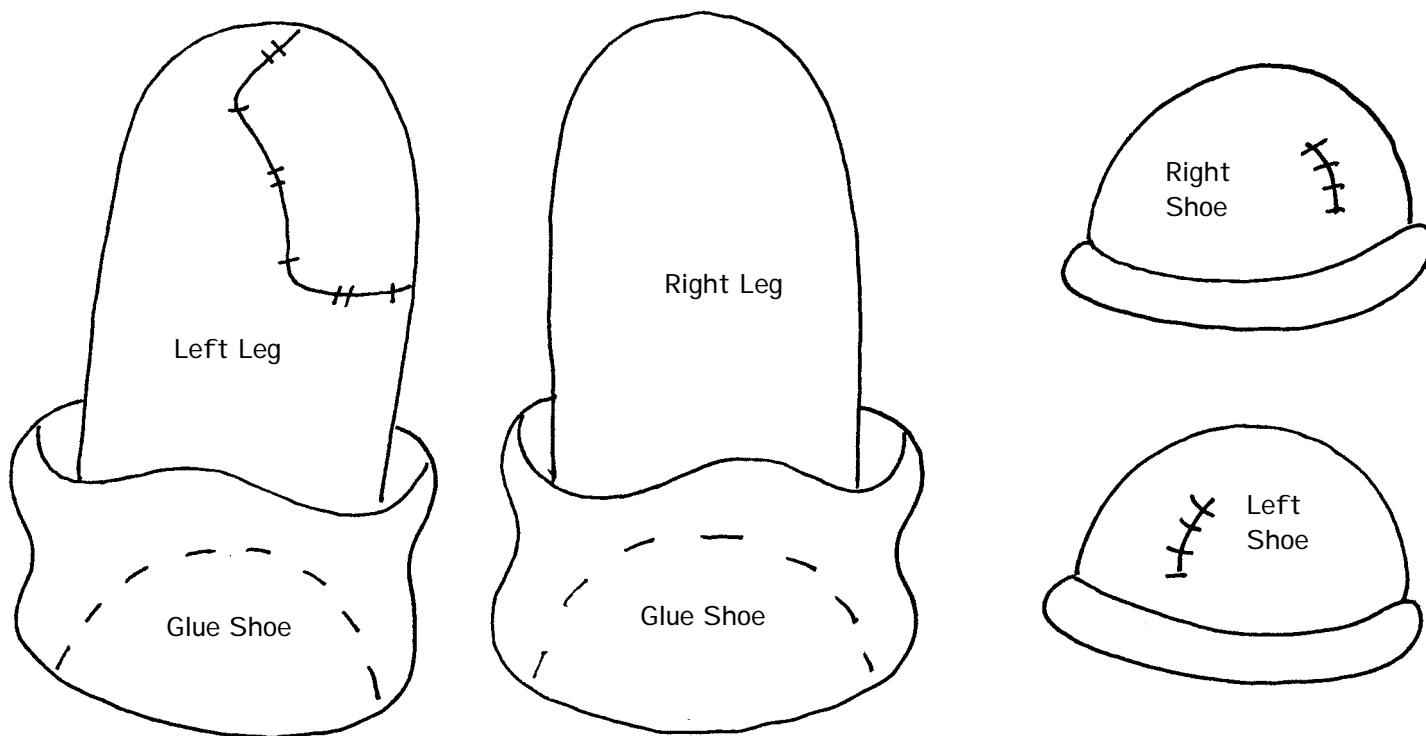
There aren't any specific painting directions for good ol' Charlie, but you have plenty of color combinations presented in the rest of the Scarecrow pattern sets to help you out.



ASSEMBLY:

1. Glue and clamp hands in place.
2. Glue and clamp feet to legs; then glue and clamp the legs to the body. You can place them straight down or slide them both sideways in opposite directions...however, you want your scarecrow swinging.
3. Glue the swing seat to the seat of your scarecrow.
4. String jute through the swing seat and hand on each side.

NOTE: You can enlarge all the pattern pieces so Charlie could swing from your tree, or you can reduce him in size to let him swing from smaller places.
